Subject: Implications of Directive on RoHS for Dynisco Products

Dynisco Instruments' understandings of RoHS (The Restriction of the Hazardous Substances) directives for Dynisco products, is as follows:

Affected Products

Dynisco: Melt Pressure Transducers, Melt Temperature Sensors, Industrial Pressure Sensors and related items produced by Dynisco Instruments and Viatran Corporation.

Dynisco: LMI 4000, On-Line Rheometers, and others products produced by Dynisco Polymer Test and Alpha Technologies.

For RoHS directives

There are 10 categories based on WEEE directives as attached, see second page.

RoHS directives are effective under eight categories #1 – 7 and #10 such as electronic devices, electronic equipments, that are put on the market in EU. The categories #8 and #9 are not included in current effective dates.

Dynisco Products are not included with RoHS directives to be effective on July 1, 2006, since they fall within are in the category #9 (Equipment "Monitoring and Control Instruments of Article 2. 1 of WEEE").

List of categories of objected products based on WEEE directives

- 2 Small electric products for domestic use
- 3 IT and other electric telecommunications equipments
- 4 Equipments for public welfare
- 5 Lighting equipments
- 6 Power tools
- 7 Toys and Apparatus for sports or amusement
- 8 Medical Instruments (Except the ones use of organ transplants or cause pollution)
- 9 Monitors and control systems
- 10 Vending machines

*Replacement products put on market before July 1, 2006, and Recycling products are not included on the above.
